ALL ABOUT YOUR NEW HOME

- Population: 3,820 according to the 2013 Census. 93% urban, 7% rural with the average age being 36.6 years.
- Location: Central Texas 55 miles west of Abilene and 107 miles east of Fort Worth on Interstate 20.
- Income: Average income per capita is \$16,989, with the average income per small household being \$34,205.
- Growth: Cisco has seen a growth of 1.77% in jobs, higher than the U.S. average of 1.18%. The estimated future growth within the next 10 years is looking to be 39.50% compared to the U.S. estimated growth of 36.10%.
- Traffic: Many people pass through Cisco on a daily basis through Interstate traffic, the main line of the Union Pacific Railway, and Cisco Municipal Airport.
- Climate: On average, Cisco gets 247 sunny days per year, but also receives 27 inches of rain fall.
- Temperature: The high in July is around 96°F, and the January low is 30°F.

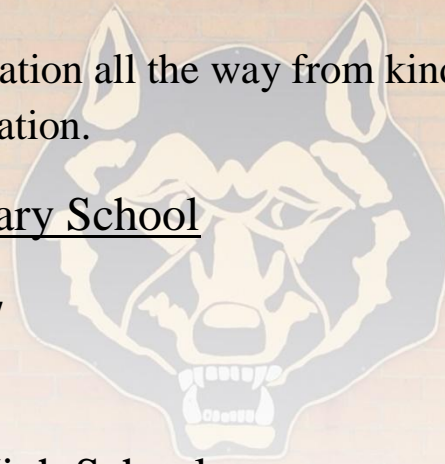
